### **Towards the end of the day**

(2003 3mins B&W Brighton)

Made on the day of my dear friend Marty Segal's death, documenting my entry to Marty's flat, with a record of his last hour.

### **The Dead Portal**

(2002 - 2mins B&W Brighton)

A spell, exploring Austin Osman Spares, experiments with magic sigils to affect events. Located in two haunted spaces -Brighton's Prince Albert public house where the ghost of a young child is said to play in the basement pool room and Castle Acre Abbey in Norfolk with the ghost of a monk. Voices are by Donatienne. Music by Testcard with Glen Langdell.

### **Angels**

(2002 4mins B&W super 8 - Paris)

Filmed in the Parisian cemetery Pere Lachaise. An experiment into darkness and light, capturing the atmosphere of the infamous 'city of the dead'. Music by Testcard

### **Ederline Avenue**

(2002 3mins B&W Norfolk)

Based on Georgi Carlisles' personal experience, Ederline Avenue was the road she would go as a child when the violence at home became unbearable. Film is shot on the beaches in Norfolk using low resolution security cameras. Music by Testcard

### **At Night i Sleep**

(2001 1min B&W Brighton)

Time Lapse Observation of the self during Sleep.Music by Testcard

### **Waiting**

(2000 1min B&W Plymouth)

A film to honour my left foot with Laura Uribe reading one of the zen poems of Ryokan, from 'Dewdrops on a Lotus Leaf'.

(2000 5mins - Brighton)

Situationist film from the D.I.Y Blackout movement.

This film, is a 'reconstruction' of events which could change your town.

(2000 5mins - Paris)

The Chilean dancer Valeria Salazar and Adrian Shephard trying to speak french in Pere Lachaise, Paris.

### **Peep Show**

(2000 10mins - Paris)

Christmas day in Paris with Dean and Eve in the notorious red light district Pigalle

### **In Search of Hitlers Bunker**

(2008 6mins - Berlin)

Lepke B, Matt Grey and Adrian Shephard disturb the peacetime of a Summer day in Berlin
